**Subject:** Implementation of Temporary Extraordinary Logistics Surcharge

Dear Valued Customer,

We are writing to inform you that due to ongoing disruption affecting key global shipping routes, Datamars is implementing a temporary **Extraordinary Logistics Surcharge** on all product shipments.

Recent geopolitical developments in the Middle East have led to significant changes in international shipping patterns, including vessel rerouting, increased transit times, and higher logistics costs. As a result, logistics providers and main raw material suppliers have introduced additional charges that are now impacting our supply chain.

To partially offset these extraordinary and externally driven costs, Datamars will apply an **Extraordinary Logistics Surcharge of 2.5% of the invoice value** on shipments of all products, effective **Friday 20th March**. The surcharge will appear as a **separate line item on invoices**.

**This measure is temporary.** We will continue to monitor the situation closely. Once conditions stabilize and these additional costs subside, the surcharge will be removed.

Datamars remains committed to maintaining reliable supply and service levels while minimizing the impact of external disruptions wherever possible.
